
## Bile Reflux and Weight Regain Post One Anastomosis Gastric Bypass

- 45 year old female transfered from another facility with a complicated surgical history for further care
- She is status post laparoscopic OAGB 3 years ago
- Before surgery BMI 50 weight 129 height 160 cm
- Weight not reached below 100 kg
- At presentation weight 112 kg BMI 43
- For the last two years patient complaining of recurrent nausea and bilious vomiting


## Work up

- WBC 5.8
- HB 9.3 Low
- Iron 19 mg/dl Low
- Ferritin 2,9 ng/dl Low
- Albumen 3.6 g/dl
- Total Protein 6.4 g/dl
- K 4.2 mmol/l
- Na 137 mmol/l
- Cl 110 mmol/l









- Patient was discharged home on POD 2
- Her diet gradually advanced and symptoms completely resolved
- Last seen 10 months post operative doing well, and weight 76kg.
