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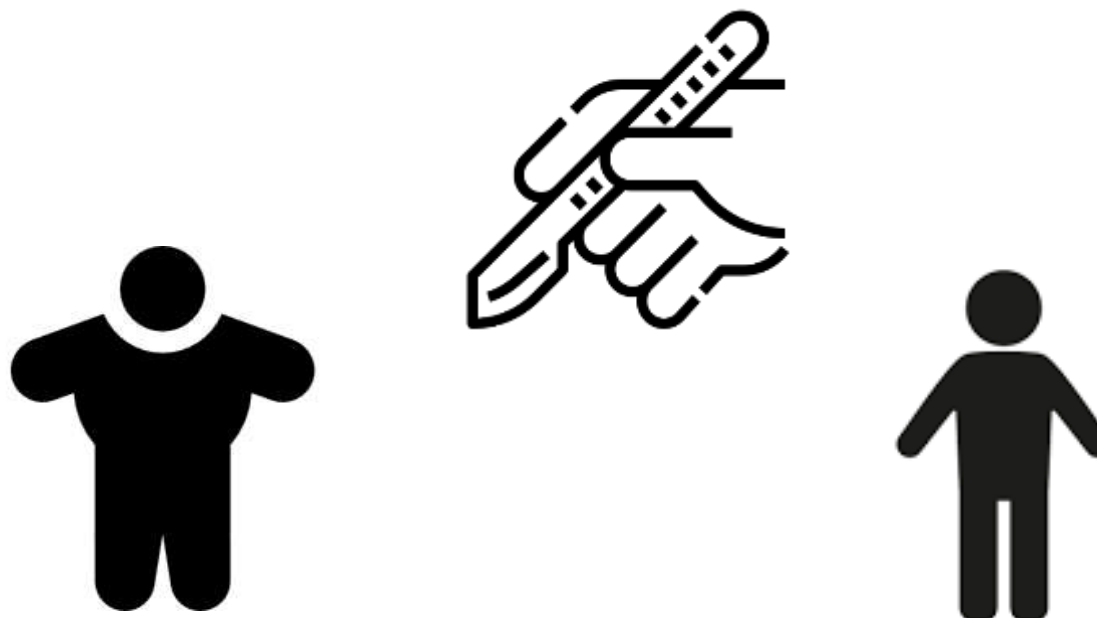

## Impact of Bariatric Surgery in the Short and Long Term: A Need for Time-Dependent Dosing of Drugs

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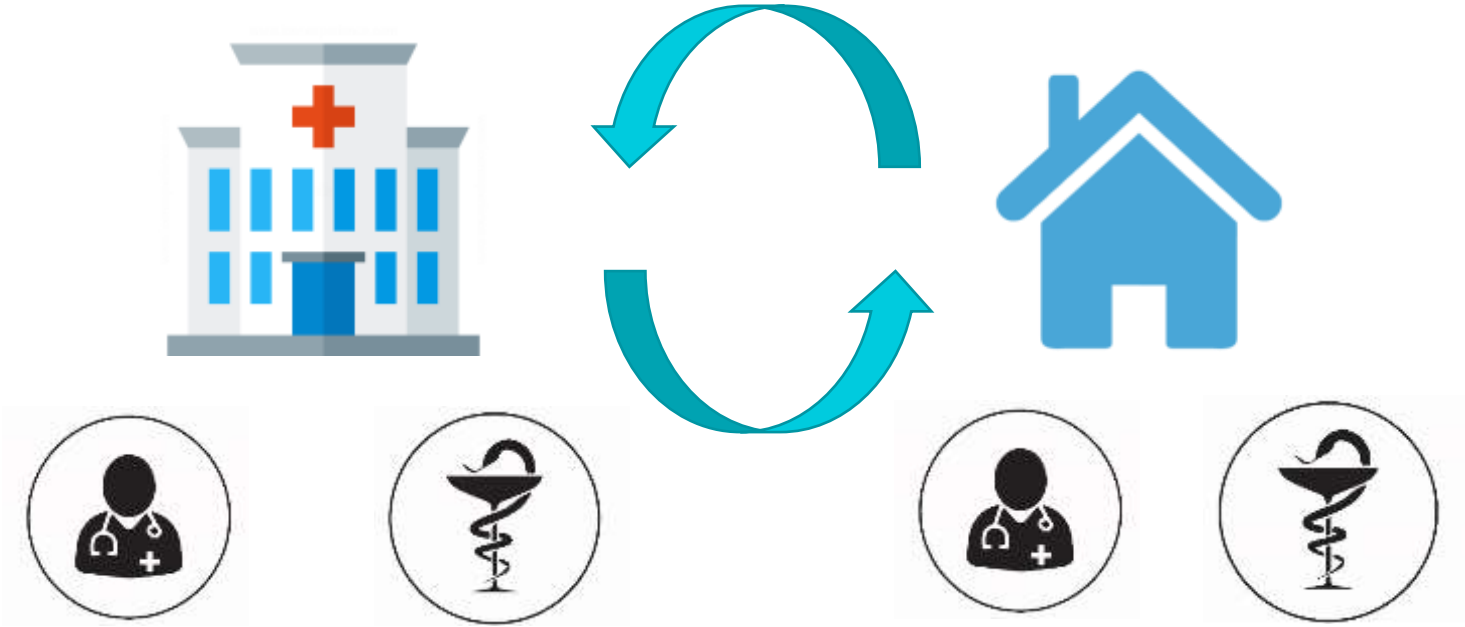
# Very few reports about changed drug effects

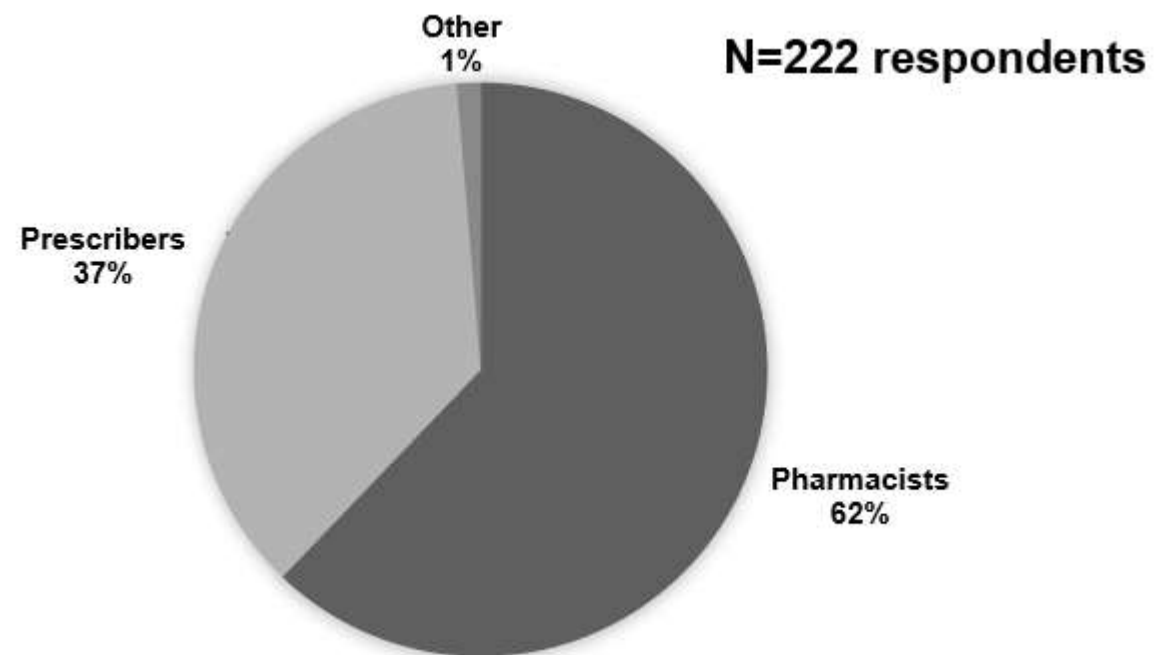

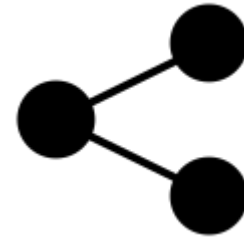
